The students will learn to light and work with a coal forge to heat metal to more than red hot and then to use hammers and other tools to forge, bend and twist the hot metal to desired shapes. Two outdoor cooking tools, the steak turner and a pair of barbecue tongs will be completed as well as a first pair of Blacksmiths' tongs.

Satisfactory completion of Introduction to Blacksmithing is required for participation in the California Blacksmith Association's Basic I Blacksmithing course. The duration of this course is three sessions.

Introduction to Blacksmithing is designed for those with an interest in learning the fundamentals of blacksmithing. The class will bring a small group of students into the Blacksmith's Shop at the AG&SEM where the students will work hands-on with a coal burning forge and learn to forge iron into useful and decorative items.

This class is intended for adults. However, responsible and well-behaved youth are invited to participate only with adult supervision and support.
